SENATE RESOLUTION

PROCLAIMING APRIL 12TH TO BE "LEAGUE DAY AT THE STATE HOUSE 2012"

Introduced By: Senators Perry, Paiva Weed, Sosnowski, Crowley, and Nesselbush Date Introduced: April 12, 2012 Referred To: Recommended for Immediate Consideration

1 WHEREAS, The League of Women Voters is a nonpartisan political organization that 2 encourages the informed and active participation of citizens in government, works to increase 3 understanding of major public policy issues, and influences public policy through education and 4 advocacy; and

5 WHEREAS, The League of Women Voters of the United States, founded by suffragists 6 in 1920, celebrated its 92nd anniversary on February 14, 2012 and continues to study and advocate 7 nationally for issues such as fair elections, open government, campaign finance reform, women's 8 rights, and clean air and environmental issues. Currently, the League is in the process of a 9 national study on privatization of public services; and

10 WHEREAS, The League of Women Voters of Rhode Island also celebrated its 92nd 11 anniversary in 2012; has recently completed a two-year statewide study of and reached consensus 12 on basic principles for education financing in Rhode Island; followed the state redistricting 13 process, and is lobbying this legislative session on redistricting, open records, open meetings, 14 ethics, election issues, campaign finance reporting and a woman's right to choice -- positions all 15 based on studies and adopted at the state and national levels. Live broadcasts this fall of nonpartisan Congressional candidate forums on ABC6-TV and RI Public Radio are being organized 16 17 and planned by the Voter Services Committee of the League; and

18 WHEREAS, Local Leagues of Women Voters in Providence, West Bay, Newport 19 County, and South Kingstown/ Narragansett will be registering voters, organizing local non-20 partisan forums for many Rhode Island legislative, town/city council and school committee candidates, and holding meetings discussing issues of interest to members and citizens regarding
 the government's role in education, charter schools, pension reform, and privatization of other
 public services; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That this Senate of the State of Rhode Island and Providence Plantations
hereby acknowledges and declares April 12, 2012, to be "League Day at the State House 2012";
and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Secretary of State be and he hereby is authorized and directed to
transmit a duly certified copy of this resolution to Derry Riding, President of the League of
Women Voters of Rhode Island.
