9	members of the Stone Hill team decided to modernize the "root cellar" concept utilized by our

12	consistent temperature, which resulted in preservation of their vegetables in a viable state for a
13	longer period of time; and
14	WHEREAS, The team was also able to perfect and complete three Robot Game
15	challenges, thereby accomplishing its missions of pollution reversal, corn harvest, and fishing;
