It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 5-45-8 of the General Laws in Chapter 5-45 entitled "Nursing

Home Administrators" is hereby amended to read as follows:

5-45-8. Licensure in other jurisdictions. -- The department may issue a nursing home

administrator's license without examination, to any person who holds a current license in good 4

5 standing as a nursing home administrator from another jurisdiction; provided, that the department

finds that the individual meets education and experience requirements as established by the

department regulation. For purposes of this section the department shall not disqualify an

8 applicant on the basis that his or her most recent experience was in a management position having

direct responsibility for overseeing and directing a number of licensed nursing home

10 administrators, rather than as an administrator of a licensed long-term care facility.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
