It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 23-19 of the General Laws entitled "Rhode Island Resource
  Recovery Corporation" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 <u>23-19-13.6. Disposal of construction and demolition debris. (a) No resource recovery</u>
- 4 system or facility made available by the corporation shall accept any construction and demolition
- 5 (C&D) debris, including wood (including painted, treated and coated wood and wood products),
- 6 wall coverings, plaster, drywall, plumbing fixtures, non-asbestos insulation, roofing shingles and
- 7 other roof coverings, and glass. Any facility violating the provisions of this section shall be fined
- 8 not less than two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500), nor more than five thousand dollars
- 9 (\$5,000). The fine shall be paid to the city or town in which the facility is located.
- 10 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
