WHEREAS, Diane C. Mederos is retiring as Bristol Town Administrator after a career
 characterized by distinguished, honorable, and devoted service to the citizens of the Town of
 Bristol; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Mederos' first elected public office was town clerk in December, 1984.
She was the first woman in Bristol to hold the office. Diane earned the trust and respect of Bristol
residents, who chose to elect her as Town Administrator in 2004. Her positive contributions to
the town resulted in three subsequent terms as Administrator; and

8 WHEREAS, A graduate of Bristol High School in 1970, Diane went on to receive a 9 Bachelor of Arts degree in Elementary Education and English from Rhode Island College in 10 1974. She earned a second degree in 1994 from Roger Williams University, in Business 11 Administration. In May, 2000, Diane was awarded a Masters Degree in Public Administration by 12 the University of Rhode Island; and

WHEREAS, Diane is affiliated with several professional organizations and is currently
serving as the President of the Rhode Island League of Cities and Towns, the first woman elected
to serve in this capacity. She also serves on the Board of Trustees of the Rhode Island Interlocal
Risk Management Trust; and

WHEREAS, Diane's accomplishments have been recognized locally and throughout the
State. In 2001, she was chosen as the Chief Marshal of the 216th Bristol Fourth of July
Celebration. She received the Outstanding Community Service Award from the Portuguese

American Women's Association in April, 2002. Diane was again honored in May, 2010, with a
 Doctor of Public Service, honoris causa, from Roger Williams University for her dedication to
 "scholarship, community and the civil exchange of ideas"; and

WHEREAS, One chapter of Diane's life is now coming to an end, but we are confident
that her future will hold many new and exciting adventures; now, therefore be it
