1 SECTION 1. Section 17-25-12 of the General Laws in Chapter 17-25 entitled "Rhode

Island Campaign Contributions and Expenditures Reporting" is hereby amended to read as

4 <u>17-25-12. Prohibited contributions. --</u> No contributions shall be made, and no

5 expenditure shall be made or incurred, whether anonymously, in a fictitious name, or by one

person or group in the name of another, to support or defeat a candidate in a primary, general, or

special election. No treasurer or candidate shall solicit or knowingly accept any contribution

contrary to the provisions of this section.

9 <u>In addition, no member of the general assembly shall accept a campaign contribution</u>

during the period from January 1, through the day of passage of the state budget by both houses

of the general assembly.

12 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
