It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 16-24 of the General Laws entitled "Children with Disabilities" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 16-24-19. Burden of production and proof. The party who filed for an impartial due
 process hearing pursuant to 34 CFR Section 300.507 et seq. has the burden of going forward with
 the evidence. In all cases, however, the public agency has the burden of proving the
 appropriateness of the child's program or placement, or of the program or placement proposed by

the public agency. This burden shall be met by a preponderance of the evidence.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

OF

AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION -- CHILDREN WITH DISABILITIES

This act would require that the party who files for an impartial due process hearing pursuant to 34 CFR Section 300.507 et seq. has the burden of going forward with the evidence and the public agency has the burden of proving the appropriateness of the child's program or placement or the proposed program or placement. The burden to be met is a preponderance of the evidence.

This act would take effect upon passage.
