It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1	SECTION 1. There shall be imposed a fee of fifty dollars (\$50.00) per semester to be
2	assessed to every student attending Brown University, the Rhode Island School of Design, and/or
3	Johnson and Wales University who is not a legal resident of the state of Rhode Island.
4	SECTION 2. Funds collected pursuant to this act shall be remitted to the state treasurer of
5	the state of Rhode Island to be placed in a restricted receipt account to be used exclusively by the
6	I-195 redevelopment commission in furtherance of the duties of said commission pursuant to
7	chapter 42-64.14.
8	SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon passage and shall be repealed on December
9	31, 2016.
