	It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:
1	SECTION 1. Sections 17-20-21 of the General Laws in Chapter 17-20 entitled "Mail
2	Ballots" are hereby amended to read as follows:
3	<u>17-20-21. Certifying envelopes</u> The secretary of state shall cause to be prepared and
4	printed and shall furnish with each mail ballot an envelope for sealing up and certifying the ballot
5	when returned. The envelope shall be printed in substantially the following form:
6	"After marking ballot or ballots, fold and enclose in this envelope and seal it. Certify to
7	statement hereon. Enclose in envelope addressed to board of elections, which must receive the
8	envelope not later than nine o'clock (9:00) eight o'clock (8:00) p.m. the day of election."

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This act would require that envelopes containing mail ballots be marked with a statement noting, in part, that the board of elections must receive the mail ballot envelope "not later than eight o'clock (8:00) pm the day of the election." The present law is nine o'clock.

This act would take effect upon passage.

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
