#### RESPECTFULLY REQUESTING THE RHODE ISLAND CONGRESSIONAL DELEGATION TO HAVE RHODE ISLAND DECLARED AN "ECONOMIC RECOVERY ZONE"

1	WHEREAS, While Rhode Island's economy is starting to show some growth and
2	recovery from the financial and economic crisis that our country has faced, a real economic
3	recovery is not possible without meaningful and effective action; and
4	WHEREAS, Recovery Zones are areas in our country having significant poverty,
5	unemployment, rate of home foreclosures, or general distress; and
6	WHEREAS, Designation as an Economic Recovery Zone is the first step towards
7	eligibility for various stimulus funding bonds and options; and
8	WHEREAS, This new type of exempt facility bond dramatically broadens financing
9	opportunities for corporate and for-profit borrowers with capital infrastructure projects; and
10	WHEREAS, In addition, this funding can provide a method of financing the capital
11	expenditures of businesses at interest rates that range from 65% to 80% of the borrower's
12	conventional bank interest rates; and
13	WHEREAS, Total recovery from this economic crisis will not happen overnight, but
14	recognizing, initiating, and establishing the necessary steps towards long-term solutions are
15	essential; now, therefore be it
16	RESOLVED, That this House of Representatives of the State of Rhode Island and
17	Providence Plantations hereby urges our state's Congressional Delegation to initiate and pursue
18	efforts to have Rhode Island declared an Economic Recovery Zone; and be it further
