It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 23-27.3-101.1 of the General Laws in Chapter 23-27.3 entitled
 "State Building Code" is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 3 23-27.3-101.1. Exemption for ordinary repairs. -- No building or structure shall be 4 constructed, extended, repaired, removed, demolished, or altered in violation of these provisions, 5 except: (1) For for ordinary repairs as defined in section 23-27.3-102.0; or (2) Those instances where the chief building official of the city or town wherein the project is located shall have 6 7 determined that the requirements of this chapter need not be enforced with respect to that 8 particular project. SECTION 2. Chapter 23-28.3 of the General Laws entitled "Fire Safety Code Board of 9 10 Appeal and Review" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section: 11 23-28.3-12. Concurrent authority of fire chiefs - Relief from responsibility. -- The 12 chief fire official of any city, town or fire district shall have the power within his or her 13 jurisdiction to grant waivers from the provisions of section 23-27.3 and shall be held harmless in
- 14 <u>life manner as set forth in section 23-28.3-11.</u>
- 15 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon passage.
