- 3 <u>39-4-25. Reporting of natural gas emergencies. -- All natural gas emergency cases.</u>
- 4 including, but not limited to, natural gas leaks, excessive carbon monoxide levels and explosions
- 5 must be reported to a dispatch office located in Rhode Island staffed by professionally trained gas
- 6 <u>dispatchers.</u>
- 7

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on July 1, 2013.
