It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 5-54-9 of the General Laws in Chapter 5-54 entitled "Physician
- 2 Assistants" is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 3 <u>5-54-9. Criteria for licensure as a physician assistant. --</u> The board shall recommend to
- 4 the director for licensure as a physician assistant an applicant who:
- 5 (1) Is of good character and reputation;
- 6 (2) Graduated from a physician assistant training program certified by the AMA's
- 7 Committee on Allied Health, Education, and Accreditation, its successor, the Commission on
- 8 Accreditation of Allied Health Education Programs (CAAHEP) accreditation review commission
- 9 <u>on education for the physician assistant (ARC-PA)</u> or its successor.
- 10 (3) Passed a certifying examination approved by the National Commission on
- 11 Certification of Physician Assistants or any other national certifying exam approved by the board.
- 12 (4) Submitted a completed application together with the required fee as set forth in
- 13 section 23-1-54.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
