It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 11-27-5 of the General Laws in Chapter 11-27 entitled "Law
- 2 Practice" is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 3 <u>11-27-5. Practice restricted to members of bar. (a)</u> No person, except a duly admitted
- 4 member of the bar of this state, whose authority as a member to practice law is in full force and
- 5 effect, shall practice law in this state.
- 6 (b) No police officer or law enforcement employee, except a duly admitted member of
- 7 the Rhode Island Bar Association, may appear before any judge or magistrate to practice law in
- 8 <u>this state.</u>
- 9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
