It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows：
SECTION 1．Section 31－3－64 of the General Laws in Chapter 31－3 entitled＂Registration of Vehicles＂is hereby amended to read as follows：

31－3－64．Combination plates．－－（a）The administrator of the division of motor vehicles shall issue：
（1）For any motor vehicle eligible for registration as a commercial vehicle having a gross weight of eight thousand eight hundred pounds（ $8,800 \mathrm{lbs}$ ．）or less，plates designated as ＂combination＂upon application and proper form furnished by the administrator of the division of motor vehicles to applicants．The combination plates will allow those vehicles to drive for both commercial and pleasure purposes；or
（2）For any motor vehicle eligible for registration as a commercial vehicle having a gross weight over eight thousand eight hundred pounds $(8,800 \mathrm{lbs}$ ．）up to eleven thousand four hundred pounds（11，400 lbs．）plates designated as＂combination＂upon application，proof of ownership of a camping trailer，fifth wheel camper trailer，travel trailer or truck camper as defined in section 31－1－3，and proper form furnished by the administrator of the division of motor vehicles to applicants．The combination plates will allow those vehicles to drive for pleasure purposes only．
（b）The fees for commercial vehicles registering for a combination plate shall be identical to those established for other commercial vehicles of the same weight．A combination registration transaction shall be considered a change to a new registration classification and not a plate change transaction．A combination registration shall be renewable during the month of

1 March each year; except that the director of the department of revenue, division of motor vehicles
2 shall implement a staggered registration system and a staggered distribution system for fully
reflective plates required to be on all vehicles pursuant to section 31-3-10.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
