It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 16-2 of the General Laws entitled "School Committees and

2 Superintendents" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

- 3 <u>16-2-33.2. City of Central Falls School dress code. The Central Falls school district</u>
- 4 governing board, in conjunction with the superintendent, may adopt a school dress code for

5 Central Falls primary, elementary, junior, and senior high school students; provided that:

- 6 (1) The principal, staff, and parents have had an opportunity to offer suggestions and
- 7 <u>comments;</u>
- 8 (2) The dress code shall be adopted at a time determined by the governing board, and the
- 9 governing board shall give notice to the parents three (3) months before a dress code is required;
- 10 <u>and</u>
- 11 (3) That on days when a nationally recognized youth organization has a scheduled
- 12 <u>function, students participating in this organization shall be exempt from the dress code on that</u>
- 13 <u>day.</u>
- 14

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
