RELATING TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES－RETAIL LICENSES

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows：
SECTION 1．Section 3－7－6 of the General Laws in Chapter 3－7 entitled＂Retail Licenses＂ is hereby amended to read as follows：

3－7－6．Renewal of Class A，Class B，Class C，Class D，Class E，and Class J licenses．－－ The holder of a Class A，Class B，Class C，Class D，Class E，or Class J license who applies before October 1 in any licensing period for a license of the same class for the next succeeding licensing period is prima facie entitled to renewal to the extent that the license is issuable under section 3－ 5－16．This application may be rejected for cause，subject to appeal as provided in section 3－7－21． A person whose application has been rejected by the local licensing authorities shall，for the purpose of license quotas under section 3－5－16，be deemed to have been granted a license until the period for an appeal has expired or until his or her appeal has been dismissed．The license holder may be required to pay a fwenty five dollar（ $\$ 25.00$ ）fee sufficient to cover costs and expenses，upon application of renewal，at the option of local licensing authorities．This fee shall be used by the local licensing authority for advertising and administrative costs related to processing the renewal application．

SECTION 2．This act shall take effect upon passage．
