It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 42-9-4 of the General Laws in Chapter 42-9 entitled "Department
- 2 of Attorney General" is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 3 <u>42-9-4. Prosecution of offenses. --</u> (a) The attorney general shall draw and present all
- 4 informations and indictments, or other legal or equitable process, against any offenders, as by law
- 5 required, and diligently, by a due course of law or equity, prosecute them to final judgment and
- 6 execution.
- 7 (b) The duty of the attorney general under this section shall include the duty to prosecute
- 8 all charges of violations of sections 31-27-2.1, 31-27-2.3, and/or 31-27-2.5, jurisdiction over the
- 9 adjudication of which is conferred upon the traffic tribunal under chapter 41.1 of title 31.
- 10 (c) The duty of the attorney general under this section shall include the duty to prosecute
- 11 <u>all charges of violations of chapter 29 of title 12.</u>
- 12 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
