CELEBRATING "NATIONAL HUNTINGTON'S DISEASE AWARENESS MONTH" DURING THE MONTH OF MAY, 2013, IN THE STATE OF RHODE ISLAND

1	WHEREAS, Huntington's Disease (HD) is a hereditary and degenerative brain disorder
2	for which there is currently no treatment or cure; and
3	WHEREAS, Huntington's Disease slowly diminishes the affected individual's ability to
4	walk, talk, and reason; and
5	WHEREAS, One out of every ten thousand Americans will be diagnosed with
6	Huntington's Disease, resulting in more than 30,000 people in the United States currently living
7	with this disease; and
8	WHEREAS, Children who have a parent diagnosed with Huntington's Disease have a
9	50/50 chance of inheriting the malady, which means at least 200,000 Americans are at risk of
10	developing HD; and
11	WHEREAS, Children who develop the juvenile form of Huntington's Disease rarely live
12	to adulthood; and
13	WHEREAS, Eventually, every person afflicted by Huntington's Disease will require full-
14	time care; and
15	WHEREAS, The goals of Huntington's Disease Awareness Month are to raise public
16	awareness and to educate all Rhode Islanders about Huntington's Disease; now, therefore be it
17	RESOLVED, That this House of Representatives of the State of Rhode Island and
18	Providence Plantations hereby fully endorses the month of May, 2013, as "National Huntington's

Disease Awareness Month" in the State of Rhode Island; and be it further

1 RESOLVED, That this House hereby commemorates the 22nd Anniversary of the 2 signing of Federal Proclamation 6295, which designated the month of May in 1991 as National 3 HD Awareness Month. We recognize Rhode Island's chapter as New England's second 4 Huntington's Disease Chapter. We further support the educational goals brought forth by this 5 resolution and urge all the citizens of our state to wear the color blue to signify remembrance of 6 Huntington's Disease awareness; and be it further 7 RESOLVED, That the Secretary of State be and hereby is authorized and directed to 8 transmit duly certified copies of this resolution to the Rhode Island chapter of the Huntington's 9 Disease Society of America.
