17	that has helped to bestow him with high morals, strong character, and a desire to serve. He is
18	married to his lovely wife, Luciann, and is the father of Anthony Paolucci, James Conti, Carolyn
19	Conti, and Lillian Conti; and

2	far safer and more secure lives due to Officer Conti's exemplary career. His dedication to the job
3	and respect for his fellow police officers will be sorely missed, although there is little doubt that
