9	have children from their previous relationships; and
10	WHEREAS, Forming healthy relationships and strong family structures is crucial to a
11	child's development and individual growth; and
12	WHEREAS, Celebration of this day gives stepparents, their children, and individual
13	family members some much deserved recognition for the value and strength they provide to the

14 very fabric of our society; now, therefore be it
