# RELATING TO EDUCATION - THE EDUCATION EQUITY AND PROPERTY TAX RELIEF $\operatorname{\mathsf{ACT}}$

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It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 16-7.2-5 of the General Laws in Chapter 16-7.2 entitled "The

Education Equity and Property Tax Relief Act" is hereby amended to read as follows:

High School, and the Metropolitan Regional Career and Technical Center. -- (a) Charter public schools defined in chapter 16-77, the William M. Davies, Jr. Career and Technical High School (Davies) and the Metropolitan Regional Career and Technical Center (the Met Center) shall be funded pursuant to section 16-7.2-3. If the October 1 actual enrollment data for any charter public school shows a ten percent (10%) or greater change from the prior year enrollment which is used as the reference year average daily membership, the third and fourth quarter payments to the charter public school will be adjusted to reflect actual enrollment. The state share of the permanent foundation education aid shall be paid by the state directly to the charter public schools, Davies, and the Met Center pursuant to section 16-7.2-9 and shall be calculated using the state share ratio of the district of residence of the student as set forth in section 16-7.2-4. The local share of education funding, as defined by the department of elementary and secondary education and approved by the General Assembly, shall be paid to the charter public school, Davies, and the Met Center by the district of residence of the student and shall be the local per pupil cost calculated by dividing the local appropriation to education from property taxes net of

debt service and capital projects as defined in the uniform chart of accounts by the average daily

- 1 membership for each city and town, pursuant to section 16-7-22, for the reference year. The
- 2 district of residence shall be responsible for the local share only when the school classification, as
- 3 <u>determined by the formula specified in the Rhode Island accountability system, of the charter</u>
- 4 <u>public school and the Met Center is higher than that of the student's comparable district school of</u>
- 5 <u>enrollment.</u>
- 6 (b) Local district payments to charter public schools, Davies, and the Met Center for
- 7 each district's students enrolled in these schools shall be made on a quarterly basis in July,
- 8 October, January and April; however, the first local district payment shall be made by August 15
- 9 instead of July. Failure of the community to make the local district payment for its student(s)
- 10 enrolled in a charter public school, Davies, and/or the Met Center may result in the withholding
- of state education aid pursuant to section 16-7-31.
- 12 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

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This act would ensure that students, and the funds appropriated by the state for local pupil costs, will go to charter public schools and to the Met Center only when said schools are performing at a higher level than the traditional schools in the student's district of residence.

This act would take effect upon passage.
