It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 22-11-1 of the General Laws in Chapter 22-11 entitled "Joint
- 2 Committee on Legislative Services" is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 3 <u>22-11-1. Permanent committee -- Composition. --</u> There is created a permanent joint
- 4 committee on legislative services consisting of the president, the majority leader and the minority
- 5 leader of the senate, the majority and minority leaders from the house of representatives, and the
- 6 speaker of the house of representatives. The members of the committee shall serve until their
- 7 successors have been duly elected and qualified.
- 8 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
