#### RELATING TO HEALTH AND SAFETY -- LICENSING OF HEALTHCARE FACILITIES

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 23-17 of the General Laws entitled "Licensing of Health Care 2 Facilities" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 23-17-49.1. Required use of a brain monitor or pulse oximeter with general
- 4 anesthesia. - Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary contained in any general or
- 5 public law, rule or regulation, during any medical procedure where a patient will be rendered
- unconscious as a result of the use of general anesthesia, a brain monitor or a pulse oximeter, 6
- 7 whereby the oxygenation of a patient is monitored, must also be used.
- 8 SECTION 2. Chapter 27-18 of the General Laws entitled "Accident and Sickness 9 Insurance Policies" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

### 27-18-79. Coverage for use of a brain monitor or pulse oximeter with general

11 anesthesia. - All expenses associated with the use of a brain monitor or a pulse oximeter are

12 eligible for reimbursement, where the use of general anesthesia is eligible for reimbursement,

- 13 under the provisions of any individual or group health insurance contract, plan or policy entered
- 14 into or renewed in this state on or after January 1, 2014.
- 15 SECTION 3. Chapter 27-19 of the General Laws entitled "Nonprofit Hospital Service
- Corporations" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section: 16
- 17 27-19-70. Coverage for use of a brain monitor or pulse oximeter with general
- 18 anesthesia. - All expenses associated with the use of a brain monitor or a pulse oximeter are
- 19 eligible for reimbursement, where the use of general anesthesia is eligible for reimbursement,

- 5 <u>27-20-66. Coverage for use of a brain monitor or pulse oximeter with general</u>
- 6 anesthesia. All expenses associated with the use of a brain monitor or a pulse oximeter are
- 7 eligible for reimbursement, where the use of general anesthesia is eligible for reimbursement,
- 8 <u>under the provisions of any individual or group health insurance contract, plan or policy entered</u>
- 9 <u>into or renewed in this state on or after January 1, 2014.</u>
- 10 SECTION 5. Chapter 27-20.1 of the General Laws entitled "Nonprofit Dental Service
- 11 Corporations" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

27-20.1-21. Coverage for use of a brain monitor or pulse oximeter with general

- 13 **anesthesia.** All expenses associated with the use of a brain monitor or a pulse oximeter are
- 14 eligible for reimbursement, where the use of general anesthesia is eligible for reimbursement,
- 15 <u>under the provisions of any individual or group health insurance contract, plan or policy entered</u>
- 16 into or renewed in this state on or after January 1, 2014.
- 17 SECTION 6. Chapter 27-41 of the General Laws entitled "Health Maintenance
- 18 Organizations" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 19 <u>27-41-83. Coverage for use of a brain monitor or pulse oximeter with general</u>
- 20 anesthesia. All expenses associated with the use of a brain monitor or a pulse oximeter are
- 21 eligible for reimbursement, where the use of general anesthesia is eligible for reimbursement,
- 22 <u>under the provisions of any individual or group health insurance contract, plan or policy entered</u>
- 23 into or renewed in this state on or after January 1, 2014.
- 24 SECTION 7. This act shall take effect upon passage.
