It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 34-39 of the General Laws entitled "Conservation and Preservation

2 Restrictions on Real Property" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

- 34-39-6. Use of eminent domain against conservation restrictions. -- Any state or
- 4 local agency that is exercising a right of eminent domain over any land which is protected with a
- 5 conservation restriction or preservation restriction shall notify the agency or organization that
- 6 holds the conservation or preservation restriction and the Rhode Island department of
- 7 environmental management at the same time they are notifying fee property owners of their
- 8 intentions to condemn the properties. Such notification will include an explanation of the public
- 9 purpose for which the land protected by the conservation or preservation restriction is being
- 10 <u>condemned.</u>

11 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

OF

AN ACT

RELATING TO PROPERTY - CONSERVATION AND PRESERVATION RESTRICTIONS ON REAL PROPERTY

1 This act would require that any state or local agency exercising a right of eminent domain 2 over any land which is protected with a conservation restriction or preservation restriction, notify 3 the agency or organization that holds the restriction and the department of environmental 4 management of their intent to condemn the properties. 5 This act would take effect upon passage.
