It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 23-28.25 of the General Laws entitled "Fire Alarm Systems" is
- 2 hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 <u>23-28.25-1.2. Disabling of fire alarms. -- (a) In any city or town where fire safety is</u>
- 4 provided solely by means of a volunteer or call fire department, certified trained personnel, other
- 5 than a firefighter, may disable a fire alarm in a commercial establishment when:
- 6 (1) There is no reasonable likelihood that the fire department will be able to respond in a
- 7 reasonable amount of time; and
- 8 (2) An investigation has determined that there is no the premises.
- 9 (b) The state fire marshal shall establish a program for the training and certification of
- 10 <u>commercial employees in fire alarm operation.</u>
- 11 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
