It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 31-27-1 of the General Laws in Chapter 31-27 entitled "Motor
- 2 Vehicle Offenses" is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 3 31-27-1. Driving so as to endanger, resulting in death. -- (a) When the death of any
- 4 person ensues as a proximate result of an injury received by the operation of any vehicle in
- 5 reckless disregard of the safety of others, including violations of section 31-27-22, the person so
- 6 operating the vehicle shall be guilty of "driving so as to endanger, resulting in death".
- 7 (b) Any person charged with the commission of this offense shall upon conviction be
- 8 imprisoned for not more than ten (10) years and have his or her license to operate a motor vehicle
- 9 suspended for no more than five (5) years.
- (c) In any prosecution under this section, the fact that the operator was engaged in
- sending or receiving text messages at the time of or immediately prior to such injury shall
- 12 constitute prima facie evidence that the operator was operating the vehicle in reckless disregard of
- the safety of others.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
