1 SECTION 1. Section 17-20-25 of the General Laws in Chapter 17-20 entitled "Mail Ballots" is hereby repealed. 2 17-20-25. Return of unused ballots. -- Every voter who has received a mail ballot and 3 4 has not east it shall nevertheless return the unvoted ballot and its uncertified enclosing envelope to the state board or local board with a statement that the voter is not using the mail ballot, before 5 6 nine o'clock (9:00) p.m. on election day. 7 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and shall apply to all elections and 8 unused ballots occurring on and after the effective date.
