It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 5-54-9 of the General Laws in Chapter 5-54 entitled "Physician

2 Assistants" is hereby amended to read as follows:

- 3 5-54-9. Criteria for licensure as a physician assistant. -- The board shall recommend to
- 4 the director for licensure as a physician assistant an applicant who:
- 5 (1) Is of good character and reputation;
- 6 (2) Graduated from a physician assistant training program certified by the AMA's

7 Committee on Allied Health, Education, and Accreditation, its successor, the Commission on

- 8 Accreditation of Allied Health Education Programs (CAAHEP) accreditation review commission
- 9 <u>on education for the physician assistant (ARC-PA)</u> or its successor.

(3) Passed a certifying examination approved by the National Commission on
Certification of Physician Assistants or any other national certifying exam approved by the board.

- 12 (4) Submitted a completed application together with the required fee as set forth in13 section 23-1-54.
- 15 section 25-1-54.
- 14 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

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EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

RELATING TO BUSINESS AND PROFESSIONS - PHYSICIANS ASSISTANT

1 This act would update section 5-54-9 to provide that the training program for physician 2 assistant be certified by the accreditation review commission on education for the physician 3 assistant (ARC-PA).

4 This act would take effect upon passage.

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
