It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 31-12-7 of the General Laws in Chapter 31-12 entitled
 "Applicability of Traffic Regulations" is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 3 <u>31-12-7. Privileges allowed emergency vehicles. --</u> The driver of an authorized
- 4 emergency vehicle may:
- 5 (1) Park or stand, irrespective of the provisions of any law;
- 6 (2) Proceed past a red or stop signal or stop sign, but only after slowing down as may be
- 7 necessary for safe operation;
- 8 (3) Exceed the prima facie speed limits so long as he or she does not endanger life or9 property;
- 10 (4) Disregard regulations governing direction of movement or turning in specified11 directions.
- 12 (5) Be exempted from wearing a seatbelt.
- 13 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
