Section 17-20-16, 17-20-21 and 17-20-22 of the General Laws in Chapter 2 17-20 entitled "Mail Ballots" are hereby amended to read as follows: 3 17-20-16. Time of casting vote. -- Mail ballots may be cast in the manner provided by 4 law on or before election day; provided, that no mail ballot shall be counted unless it is received by the state board not later than nine o'clock (9:00) p.m. local time the time prescribed by section 5 <u>17-18-11</u> for the closing of polling places on election day. 6 7 17-20-21. Certifying envelopes. -- The secretary of state shall cause to be prepared and printed and shall furnish with each mail ballot an envelope for sealing up and certifying the ballot 8 9 when returned. The envelope shall be printed in substantially the following form: 10 "After marking ballot or ballots, fold and enclose in this envelope and seal it. Certify to 11 statement hereon.
