11	career as a firefighter. He joined the Central Coventry Fire District in 1991, where his leadership
12	skills and abilities garnered attention and respect from his peers. Captain Hall established and was
13	coordinator of the Community Emergency Response Team (CERT). He was also a member of
14	the Coventry Arson Task Force, served on the Coventry Town Council and the Coventry Housing
15	Association, and was Chairman of the Coventry Sewer Board; and
16	WHEREAS, Even though we are diminished by this loss and mourn William's passing,
17	so, too, must we celebrate the spirit, generosity, and courage with which he lived every day of his
