POSTHUMOUSLY HONORING ROBERT J. SULLIVAN ON HIS INDUCTION INTO THE RHODE ISLAND RADIO HALL OF FAME

1 WHEREAS, The Rhode Island Radio Hall of Fame was established in 2008 to celebrate 2 the medium's history in the Ocean State. Being an Inductee into the organization is a momentous 3 tribute to those who have played a significant role in radio's history and growth in our state; and 4 WHEREAS, The late Robert J. Sullivan, better know as "Radio Bob" to WADK-AM listeners, has been posthumously honored as one of the class of 2013's inductees; and 5 6 WHEREAS, Born in 1949 to James and Ruth Sullivan of Newport, Bob was a graduate 7 of Rogers High School and studied journalism at the University of Rhode Island; and 8 WHEREAS, Bob had a passion for radio. In 1972, he began working part-time at the 9 WADK studio covering the Middletown and Portsmouth council meetings. In 1983, he became an on-air personality by inheriting the "Open Forum" call-in show from Francis "Sully" Sullivan. 10 11 His career in radio spanned more than thirty-five years; and 12 WHEREAS, A consummate Newporter, Bob was one of the original judges for the Irish 13 Coffee Competition held in Newport. He was also a member of the Newport Jaycees, a 14 toastmaster at the Hibernian St. Patrick's Day Roast, and Grand Marshall for the 41st St. Patrick's 15 Day Parade in Newport; and 16 WHEREAS, Throughout his lifetime, Bob Sullivan earned a reputation for excellence. He passed away in 2007, but his memorable quick wit, sense of humor, and wide range of 17 18 interests left an enduring impact on the industry and a legacy that is worthy of our recognition
