Office of Regulatory Reform, to be appointed by the Governor; one of whom shall be a

- 1 representative of the business industry, to be appointed by the Speaker; one of whom shall be a
- 2 municipal planner, to be appointed by the President of the Senate; and one of whom shall be a
- 3 municipal zoning official, to be appointed by the President of the Senate.
