It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 5-49-13 of the General Laws in Chapter 5-49 entitled "Hearing Aid
- 2 Dealers and Fitters" is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 3 <u>5-49-13. Prohibited acts and practices.</u> – (a) No person shall:
- (1) Sell, barter, or offer to sell or barter, a license. 4
- 5 (2) Purchase or procure by barter a license with intent to use it as evidence of the 6 holder's qualifications to practice the fitting and sale of hearing aids.
- 7 (3) Alter a license with fraudulent intent.
- 8 (4) Use or attempt to use as a valid license a license which has been purchased,
- 9 fraudulently obtained, counterfeited, or materially altered.
- 10 (5) Willfully make a false statement in an application for license or application for
- renewal of a license. 11
- 12 (b) The sale and/or delivery of hearing aids through the internet or direct mail is
- prohibited and shall be punishable by a fine of not more than five hundred dollars (\$500) or 13
- 14 imprisonment for not more than ninety (90) days, or both.
- 15 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
