It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 5-53.1-12.1 of the General Laws in Chapter 5-53.1 entitled
 "Solicitation by Charitable Organizations" is hereby amended to read as follows:
- <u>5-53.1-12.1. Solicitation -- Requirements. --</u> Prior to orally requesting a contribution, or
 contemporaneously with a written request for a contribution, <u>regardless of how the request is</u>
 <u>made</u>, the following shall be clearly and conspicuously disclosed:
- 6 (a) The name of the professional solicitor and professional fund-raiser, the name of the
- 7 <u>entity that employed or otherwise engaged the professional solicitor or professional fund-raiser</u>,
- 8 and the fact that the solicitation is being conducted by a professional solicitor.
- 9 (b) If requested by the prospective donor, the <u>The</u> percentage of the contribution to be 10 retained by the professional fund-raiser <u>or the company that employed or otherwise engaged the</u>
- 11 professional fund-raiser.
- 12 (c) Any solicitation that is subject to this section, regardless of how the solicitation is
- 13 made, shall include the following statement:
- 14 "My name is [insert full name] and I am an employee of [insert name of fundraising
- 15 <u>company</u>]. I am a paid representative soliciting charitable contributions on behalf of [insert name
- 16 of charitable organization]. I am required by Rhode Island law to inform you that [insert name of
- 17 <u>fundraising company] receives no less than [insert percentage] percent of aggregate contributions</u>
- 18 in payment for its fundraising services."

EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

1 This act would require professional solicitors and professional fund-raisers to disclose the

2 percentage of a contribution retained by a fundraising company. This act also would require that a

3 specific statement be made with all solicitations.
