### RELATING TO MOTOR AND OTHER VEHICLES -- ADJUDICATION OF TRAFFIC OFFENSES--SCHEDULE OF VIOLATIONS

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 31-41.1-4 of the General Laws in Chapter 31-41.1 entitled
"Adjudication of Traffic Offenses" is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 <u>**31-41.1-4. Schedule of violations. --**</u> (a) The penalties for violations of the enumerated 4 sections, listed in numerical order, correspond to the fines described. However, those offenses for 5 which punishments may vary according to the severity of the offense, or punishment that require 6 the violator to perform a service, shall be heard and decided by the traffic tribunal or municipal 7 court. The following violations may be handled administratively through the method prescribed 8 in this chapter. This list is not exclusive and jurisdiction may be conferred on the traffic tribunal 9 with regard to other violations.
