It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 16-22 of the General Laws entitled "Curriculum" is hereby
 amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 <u>16-22-27. Availability of instruction in musical performance education. All</u>
- 4 secondary public schools including middle schools, or any other secondary schools managed and
- 5 controlled by the state, are strongly encouraged to offer as a part of the curriculum, courses in
- 6 performing arts, including musical ensembles, such as band, chorus, orchestra and other
- 7 performance ensembles, with emphasis upon development of aesthetic appreciation and the skills
- 8 of creative expression.
- 9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on July 1, 2015.
