SECTION 1. Chapter 5-14 of the General Laws entitled "Hotels" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

5-14-6. Mandatory release of information to law enforcement. – If, in the course of a criminal investigation, any law enforcement agency shall request information regarding a patron or patrons from the operator of a hotel, as defined in § 5-14-3, said operator shall provide the requesting law enforcement agency with any such information in the operator's possession, including the name, address, phone number, automobile registration, and other identifying
