Mr. Speel served our nation with honor and integrity in 4 the military during the Vietnam era; and

5 WHEREAS, Mr. Speel began his distinguished public service career more than thirtyeight years ago, on September 20, 1976, when he was hired by the Woonsocket Housing 6 7 Authority. From his first day on the job, his colleagues and superiors noticed his attention to detail, his tireless work ethic and his innovative approach to problem solving. As a result, he 8 9 began to rise in the ranks, culminating with his promotion to the position of Deputy Director; and 10 WHEREAS, Mr. Speel participated in numerous training programs throughout his career 11 including, those offered by the Institute for Real Estate Management, the National Association of 12 Housing and Redevelopment Officials (NAHRO), The National Center for Housing Management 13 (NCHM) and with Nan McKay & Associates. All of this training allowed Mr. Speel to gather an 14 immense amount of knowledge regarding Real Estate and Housing issues, and enabled him to 15 establish a highly regarded preventative maintenance program for all of the Woonsocket Housing 16 Authority's property and equipment.
