WHEREAS, The Pell Awards, now in their 19th year, recognize and celebrate artistic
 excellence in Rhode Island, support the Trinity Repertory Company, and honor Senator Claiborne
 Pell's legacy of vigorous support of the arts, including his sponsorship of legislation that created
 the National Endowment for the Humanities in 1965; and

5 WHEREAS, Esteemed Actress Debra Messing will be awarded the Pell Award for 6 Distinguished Achievement in the Arts on June 15, 2015, at the 19th annual Pell Awards Gala; 7 and

8 WHEREAS, Ms. Messing was born in Brooklyn, New York, the daughter of Sandra and 9 Brian Messing. As a young child, she and her family moved to East Greenwich, Rhode Island. 10 She attended East Greenwich High School where she thrived as both a student and a performer on 11 stage starring in various plays including the musicals Annie and Grease. After graduating from 12 East Greenwich High School, she attended Brandeis University, where she graduated Summa 13 Cum Laude with a Bachelor of Arts degree in Theater Arts. She was later accepted into the very 14 prestigious Graduate Acting Program at New York University, and earned a Master of Fine Arts 15 degree; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Messing first gained notice as an actress when she received rave
reviews for her performances in the pre-Broadway workshop production of *Angels in America*: *Perestroika*. After working in a variety of television shows and film productions in a supporting
role, Debra landed a starring role in the landmark and groundbreaking television series, *Will &*

Grace. For her work on this highly successful series, Debra won a 2003 Emmy Award, earned seven Golden Globe nominations, seven Screen Actors Guild nominations, five additional Emmy nominations, two American Comedy Award nominations, and two People's Choice Award nominations. She was also named TV Guide's Actress of the Year in a Comedy Series in 2001; and

- WHEREAS, Since her break-out success on *Will & Grace*, Ms. Messing has gone on to
 star in movies, work on Broadway, and currently stars in the television show the *Mysteries of Laura*. She also supports many charitable endeavors and is a passionate advocate of various
 global health initiatives; now, therefore be it
