It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 39-3 of the General Laws entitled "Regulatory Powers of
Administration" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

3 <u>39-3-45. Electric rates tied to the consumer price index. – (a) Notwithstanding any</u>

4 provisions of the general laws to the contrary, any increase in rates proposed to be charged by an

5 electric distribution company as defined in chapter 1 of this title, shall be no greater than five and

6 <u>one-half percent (5.5%) or the percentage increase in the Consumer Price Index for all Urban</u>

- 7 Consumers (CPI-U) as published by the United States Department of Labor Bureau of Labor
- 8 Statistics determined as of September 30 of the prior calendar year, whichever is greater, unless
- 9 <u>the increase shall have been previously approved by affirmative action of the general assembly.</u>
- 10 (b) The provisions of this section shall not apply to any electric distribution company
- 11 <u>having fewer than seven thousand five hundred (7,500) electricity customer accounts.</u>
- 12 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

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EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

OF

AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC UTILITIES AND CARRIERS -- REGULATORY POWERS OF ADMINISTRATION

1 This act would provide that any rate increase with respect to electric distribution 2 companies would be no greater than the increase in the Consumer Price Index or five and one-3 half percent (5.5%), whichever is greater, without prior approval of the general assembly.

This act would take effect upon passage.

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
