WHEREAS, The State of Rhode Island takes great pride in the academic aspirations of its high school students; and

WHEREAS, The State of Rhode Island takes great pride in our local universities academic and athletic prowess; and

WHEREAS, The State of Rhode Island takes great pride in the community of excellence fostered by its universities; and

WHEREAS, The education, fishing, and the hospitality and tourism industries are crucial to the economy of the state; and

WHEREAS, The State of Rhode Island takes great pride in our unmatched bounty of seafood and culinary excellence; and

WHEREAS, Rhode Island fisheries supply twenty-five percent of the United States' total commercial catch of quahogs making this unique clam a cornerstone of Rhode Island's identity and economy; and

WHEREAS, Collegiate athletic competition holds a special place in our community, as it brings people together, fosters relationships, and creates tradition. Collegiate competition is cathartic, and symbolic. It gives pride to many, and nowhere is this more meaningful and true than in the thrill of collegiate tournaments; and

WHEREAS, The incredible influx of money into collegiate athletics often fails to benefit students; and

WHEREAS, Our sense of pride and community is never stronger than during the week of Thanksgiving, when friends and family return home to their Rhode Island roots to give thanks; and

WHEREAS, The State of Rhode Island is home to four Division I college basketball teams, The Brown University Bears, the Bryant University Bulldogs, The Providence College Friars, and The University of Rhode Island Rams; and

WHEREAS, The State of Rhode Island and its many residents, as well as the proud fans, students, faculty, administration, and alumni, of Brown University, Bryant University, Providence College, and the University of Rhode Island, have a special interest in building a great tradition that will promote our state's pride and its tourism and hospitality industries; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That this Senate of the State of Rhode Island and Providence Plantations hereby encourages and supports the creation of the Quahog Cup, an annual men's and women's college basketball tournament to include Brown University, Bryant University, Providence College, and the University of Rhode Island, to support a scholarship fund for Rhode Island public school students wishing to attend Rhode Island colleges; and be it further
