It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 37-2 of the General Laws entitled "State Purchases" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

37-2-81. Selection of vendors and services based on economic security and pay

equality. – The director of the department of administration is authorized and directed to

promulgate rules and regulations giving preference in contract and/or subcontract awards to

business enterprises whose highest paid executive receives compensation and/or salary equal to

twenty-five (25) times or less than the median compensation and/or salary paid to its nonexecutive employees. To the extent that any of the provisions contained in this section conflict

with the requirements for federal contracts, federal law and/or regulations shall control.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
