It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 4-24-8 of the General Laws in Chapter 4-24 entitled "Permit
- 2 Program for Cats" is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 3 <u>4-24-8. Abandonment of cats. --</u> If any cat is abandoned by their owner or any person
- 4 having charge or custody of that cat, that person shall, for each offense be punished in the manner
- 5 provided in § 4-1-2. This section shall not apply to "licensed releasing agencies" as defined in §
- 6 4-19-2(17).
- 7 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
