It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 40-8.13-6 of the General Laws in Chapter 40-8.13 entitled "Long-
- 2 Term Managed Care Arrangements" is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 3 40-8.13-6. Payment incentives. -- In order to encourage quality improvement and
- 4 promote appropriate utilization incentives for providers in a managed long-term care
- 5 arrangement, a managed care organization may use incentive or bonus payment programs that are
- 6 in addition to the rates identified in § 40-18.13-5. <u>In addition, managed care organizations shall</u>
- 7 work in consultation with the EOHHS to develop incentives for nursing facilities that
- 8 demonstrate lower direct care staff turnover.
- 9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
