It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 12-19.2 of the General Laws entitled "Sentencing to Life
- 2 Imprisonment Without Parole" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 <u>12-19.2-7. Juveniles.</u> Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter, any
- 4 provision of the general or public laws to the contrary, or § 11-23-2, no person who was less than
- 5 eighteen (18) years of age at the time the offense was committed shall be sentenced to life
- 6 <u>imprisonment without parole.</u>
- 7 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
