It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 16-22 of the General Laws entitled "Curriculum [See Title 16
2	Chapter 97 - The Rhode Island Board of Education Act]" is hereby amended by adding thereto
3	the following section:
4	<u>16-22-27. Availability of instruction in musical performance education. – (a) All</u>
5	secondary public schools including middle schools, or any other secondary schools managed and
6	controlled by the state shall offer as a part of the curriculum, courses in musical performing arts,
7	including, but not limited to, band, chorus, orchestra and other performance ensembles, with
8	emphasis upon development of aesthetic appreciation and the skills of creative expression.
9	(b) All secondary school principals shall meet annually with the music department to
10	analyze student scheduling to maximize music performing ensembles within the school
11	<u>curriculum.</u>

12 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on July 1, 2015.
