It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 44-30 of the General Laws entitled "Personal Income Tax" is

2 hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

3 <u>44-30-101. Allowance of medical and dental deduction. – There shall be allowed as a</u>

Rhode Island personal income tax deduction, the expenses paid during the taxable year, not

5 compensated for by insurance or otherwise, for medical and dental care of the taxpayer, the

6 <u>taxpayer's spouse, or a dependent in accordance with the provisions set forth in 26 U.S.C. 213.</u>

7 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

This act would create a Rhode Island income tax deduction for medical and dental expenses not covered by insurance, provided the taxpayer qualifies for the deduction under federal law (26 U.S.C. 213).
