It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 17-20-19 of the General Laws in Chapter 17-20 entitled "Mail
 Ballots" is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 3 <u>17-20-19. Envelopes for return of ballots. --</u> Envelopes for the enclosure and return of
- 4 mail ballots and their enclosing certified envelope shall have the printed or written address:
- 5 "Board of Elections, 50 Branch Ave., Providence, Rhode Island 02904-2790" of the board of
- 6 <u>elections</u>; and shall be forwarded by the secretary of state to each mail voter whose application
- 7 for the mail ballot has been received and accepted.
- 8 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

1 This act would delete the specification of the address of the board of elections from the 2 return envelopes provided for mail ballots and would require only that the address of the board of 3 elections be on the return envelope.
